Fire Protection Plans



The Brian Head Fire Department works in conjunction with the Forest Service, home owners, and business owners, to help facilitate fire protection plans. These plans enable home and business owners to implement fire protection ideas at their property.



The Fire Protection Plans include ideas such as:

- Removing trees and shrubbery away from structures
- Burning dead fall on your property
- Cutting fire breaks along property lines
- Contacting the Fire Department with any potential Fire Hazards

If you are wanting to burn slash during the appropriate seasons, you will need to obtain a burn permit from the Brian Head Public Safety Department. Please submit a request and depending on the season, the Public Safety Department will issue burn permits. Please remember that garbage is not allowed to be burned.
